

## Polridmouth Beach



- Description: Polridmouth is a pleasant cove with two sandy beaches, which are joined together at low tide. There are no facilities or toilets and parking is some distance away from the beach
- Safety: No details available
- Access: The path to Polridmouth Beach is not suitable for wheelchairs. Final access to the beach is via steps
- Dogs: Dogs allowed all year on Polridmouth Beach
- Directions: Polridmouth is about 7 miles from St Austell and 19 miles from Liskeard. Approaching from the east or west on the A390 turn onto the B3269 for Fowey (this junction is about 2 miles west of Lostwithiel and is signposted to Fowey). Shortly before Fowey turn right at a roundabout onto the A3082 (signposted to St Austell). Take the next left (signposted to Polkerris and Menabilly) and continue on this road to a car park at Menabilly. Polridmouth Beach is a 20 minute walk from the car park
