

Portscatho Beach



- Description:Portscatho is an attractive fishing village with a beach which is mainly rock but with sandy patches. Portscatho beach stretches all the way to Porthcurnick Beach to the north
- Safety:No details available
- Access:There is a sloping path from the car park to the village, which takes about 10 minutes to walk. Final access to the beach and harbour are via short slopes
- Dogs:No details available
- Directions:Portscatho is 13 miles from Truro and 16 miles from St Austell. Aproaching from the east or west on the A390 about 4 miles east of Truro turn onto the A3078 for St Mawes. Continue on the A3078 until Trewithian. At Trewithian turn left for Portscatho. Take the next left and there is a small car park just before Portscatho village
- Parking:One small car park, a 10 minute walk from Portscatho village
- Toilets:Yes, by the beach
- Facilities:Pub,shops
- Activities:None
