

Porthcothan Beach



- Description:Porthcothan Beach is a pleasant family beach with plenty of sand at low tide and some sand dunes. Parking and toilets are close to the beach at Porthcothan
- Safety:Lifeguards in summer at Porthcothan
- Access:The car park is several minute walk from the beach and the path to Porthcothan Beach is level There are also steps to the beach from the coast path
- Dogs:Dogs allowed all year at Porthcothan
- Directions:Porthcothan is approximately 10 miles from Newquay. On the A30 near Indian Queens turn onto the A39 at the Highgate Hill roundabout. Proceed on the A39 north and continue on the A39 across the 1st roundabout. Continue on the A39 and at the 2nd roundabout (Trenkenning roundabout) take the first left onto the A3059 (signposted for Newquay). After about 2 miles turn right, signposted to Watergate Bay and Mawgan Porth. Continue on this road until a junction and here turn right onto the B3276 (signposted to Padstow and Mawgan Porth). Follow this road through Mawgan Porth and about 3 miles after Mawgan Porth the B3276 drops down to Porthcothan
- Parking:1 Council run car park at Porthcothan, a short walk from Porthcothan Beach
- Toilets:Yes, by the Porthcothan car park
- Facilities:Beach Shop at Porthcothan Beach
- Activities:Surfing

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
