

- Description:At Cape Cornwall there is a small cove called Priests Cove with a pebble beach and lots of rock pools. There is also a small tidal pool. Its definitely worth climbing the footpath up to the Cape for spectacular views
- Safety:No details available
- Access:There is a sloping road/path to the beach and final access is via a slipway
- Dogs:Dogs allowed all year at Cape Cornwall
- Directions: Cape Cornwall is approximately 9 miles from Penzance. Follow the A30 around the outskirts of Penzance then turn right onto the A3071 for St Just and follow this road to St Just. At St Just turn left for Cape Cornwall (signposted to Cape Cornwall). Then follow this road for several miles to Cape Cornwall
- Parking:1 National Trust car park at Cape Cornwall
- Toilets:Yes at the Cape Cornwall car park
